Directions

From Hwy 12 W of Helena: At the Shelly's Country Cafe (formally Red Roof Cafe) on Euclid Ave (Hwy 12 W), go north on Joslyn St. At the fork, veer left onto Country Club Ave. Watch for Spring Meadow Lake on your left. At the end of Country Club Ave, turn right onto Williams St. Go .5 Miles. Continue on Birdseye Rd for 10 miles. At Junction of Lincoln Rd/MT 279, turn left. Go 5 miles. Ride Camp at mile marker 12 on left.

From Hwy 15 N of Helena: Take Exit 200 onto Lincoln Rd. Go west on Lincoln Rd, 12 Miles. Ride Camp on Left at Mile Marker 12.

From Lincoln MT: Go east of Lincoln on Hwy 200 for 11 miles. Turn right on Flesher Pass Rd. for 25 miles on MT 279. Pass Canyon Creek and just past mile marker 13, turn right into Ride Camp.

Ride camp

On private ranch in a large grassy cattle-grazing area. Lots of room for big rigs. Horse water is provided. Bring your own potable water. Portable outhouses available. Dogs welcome - please keep them under control. Weed-free hay is required and will be available for purchase. You may spread manure, but please pack out your trash. Fire danger will likely be high, so no camp fires, but, we might have one community fire.

Trails

Private ranch land. Varied terrain through beautiful forested areas with scenic overlooks and trails. Foothills with two-track areas. Some dirt road and rocky areas. Some gates. NO Out-of-camp vet check. Lunch and refreshments provided at ride camp.

Vetting

Pre-ride vetting for Saturday riders will start at ride camp about 4 p.m. on Friday. Pre-ride vetting for Sunday riders will start Saturday afternoon at vet's discretion.

Ride meetings

Friday evening at 7:30 p.m. for Saturday riders. Dinner Saturday evening starting at 6:30 p.m. For Sunday riders, ride meeting Saturday evening immediately following the awards presentations starting at 7:00 p.m.

Entry fees and start times

25 miles, \$80, 50 miles, \$90. 2-day 100, \$150. Ride times are weather dependent and determined by the head veterinarian. Ride times will be announced at the ride meeting. \$10 discount per ride for paid registration postmarked before Aug. 1. Fun riders can do an 8-mile trail each day, \$35, start anytime between 9 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. each day. Entry fees include dinner Saturday evening. Additional dinner tickets are \$10.
